The Level 2 Umpire Training Program is designed to train umpires in the essential concepts of umpiring including psychological and physical preparation; umpiring skills and tools; player management; communication; risk management and ethical responsibilities.

It is a comprehensive training program involving seminars, practical activities, pre and post seminar requirements and a practical assessment. The program is directed towards umpires involved in the higher levels of junior or senior level of club/ school or representative hockey.
