

## **Level 1 Umpire**

The Level 1 Umpire Training Program is designed to train umpires in the fundamental concepts of umpiring including fitness, positioning, signals and ensuring the safety and enjoyment of players.

It is an enjoyable and convenient training program involving an online learning session, an applied learning quiz, a 1 day practical course and a practical evaluation. The program is directed towards parents, players and umpires who are involved in umpiring club hockey, Intra-state Championships and low level National Championships.

The Level 1 Umpire training program can be accessed as an educational resource for currently accredited individuals, as well as being a training requirement for those wishing to obtain their Level 1 Umpire Accreditation.

### **Steps to complete the Level 1 Umpire Accreditation Training Program:**

Pre-requisite: No pre-requisite

1. [View Competencies](#): To gain a Level 1 Umpire accreditation you must be able to demonstrate the required competencies.
2. [Register here](#): Register for an account on our new learning platform HockeyEd (if you don't have one already).
3. [Start Level 1 Umpire](#): There is a registration fee of \$40 to complete the Level 1 Umpire program, payable via PayPal when you enrol in the course.

### **The Level 1 Umpire program is in three parts:**

- Hockey specific online training program - includes an applied learning quiz which takes approximately one to two hours to complete
- A practical evaluation of one match minimum as an umpire.
- A 1 Day Practical course conducted by your State Association.
