The Advanced Coach Training Program is designed to train coaches in the advanced concepts of coaching including self-management skills; skill and tactical development; playing styles and structures; player and team analysis; sports science; communication skills; championship regulations and risk management. It is a comprehensive and challenging training program involving presentations by participants, role play scenario's, practical training and coaching sessions, applied learning, self-development requirements and a practical evaluation.
